■ Comma (Addresses and Nonrestrictive Phrases and Clauses), Apostrophe (Possessives), Misplaced Modifier

■ Colon, Comma (Nonrestrictive Phrases and Clauses), Spelling

■ Comma (Between Independent Clauses), Subject-Verb Agreement, Apostrophe, Using the Right Word
